

PROPOSAL FOR A SUMMER SCHOOL FOR BUCEA STUDENTS

The University of South Wales is delighted to offer a bespoke summer school for BUCEA students. The course can be run over three or four weeks during July or August and will comprise of IELTS-focussed communicative language classes as well as cultural visits and activities.

The University of South Wales (USW) has its main campus at Treforest, a quiet town in the rolling Welsh hills just fifteen minutes north of Cardiff, the capital city of Wales. This part of the UK is safe, clean and has a relatively low cost of living, so it really is the ideal base for international students wishing to develop their skills during their holidays!
